

What is genomic testing?

Genomic testing is an important step after receiving a cancer diagnosis that can help your doctor personalise your treatment.


- A genomic test scans your tumour cells for certain changes called mutations
- By identifying these mutations, your doctor can determine treatments that may be best for you

Traditional tissue testing has limitations



Limited Tissue Availability

Tissue may not provide the amount of testing material needed for complete results



Incomplete Testing

Using tissue testing alone may not find all the mutations you may have, causing you to potentially miss out on available treatment options




Delayed results

It can often take a month or longer to collect tissue, analyse the sample, and receive results, leading to delays in starting the ideal treatment

As an alternative to invasive tissue testing, a liquid biopsy can be completed in your doctor's office through a simple blood draw.
